The word biology is made of two Greek words *bios* which means “life” and *ology* which means “the study of”. Biology is the study of life and living organisms, from one-celled creatures to the most complex living organism of all — the human being. Biology includes the study of genes and cells that give living things their special characteristics.¹ The Bible teaches that life is from Christ who is the giver of life. “In Him (Jesus Christ) was life, and the life was the light of men.” John 1:4
