God's Law of Completion

- God's work of creation was **finished** on the 7th day of creation week. Genesis 2:1-3
- God's work of salvation was **finished** on the day Jesus rose from the dead. Hebrews 1:3

Nothing else is needed.

God's Law of Completion

What does it mean for us?

- Creation was complete. Nothing more needed to be made. Evolution is contrary to this concept.
- Christ Jesus paid the entire penalty for our sins and gave us salvation. Nothing more needs to be done except to receive the gift of salvation.

God saved you by His grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. Ephesians 2:8-9

First Law of Thermodynamics

Energy and matter cannot be created or destroyed; it can only be converted from one form to another.

Mass of reactants = Mass of products



First Law of Thermodynamics


$$\Delta Q = \Delta U + W$$
$$\Delta U = \Delta Q - W$$

ΔQ = the heat given or lost
 ΔU = the change in internal energy
 W = the work done




