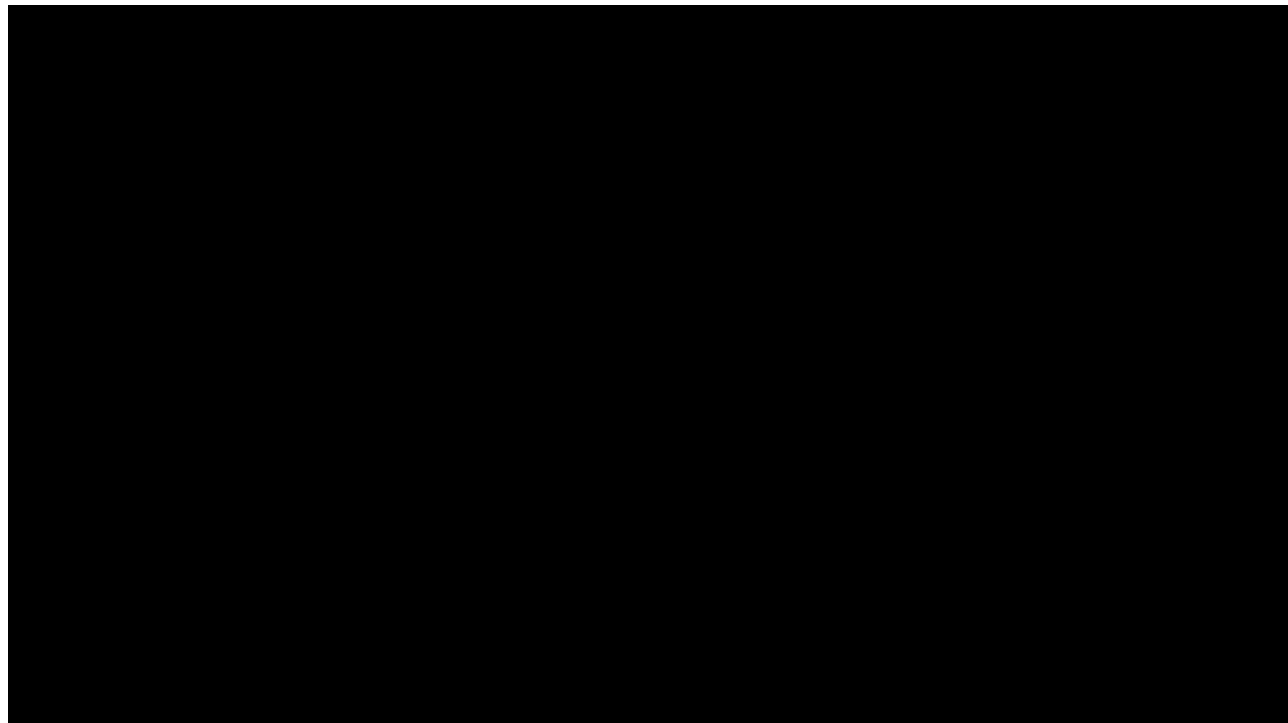

- And ...



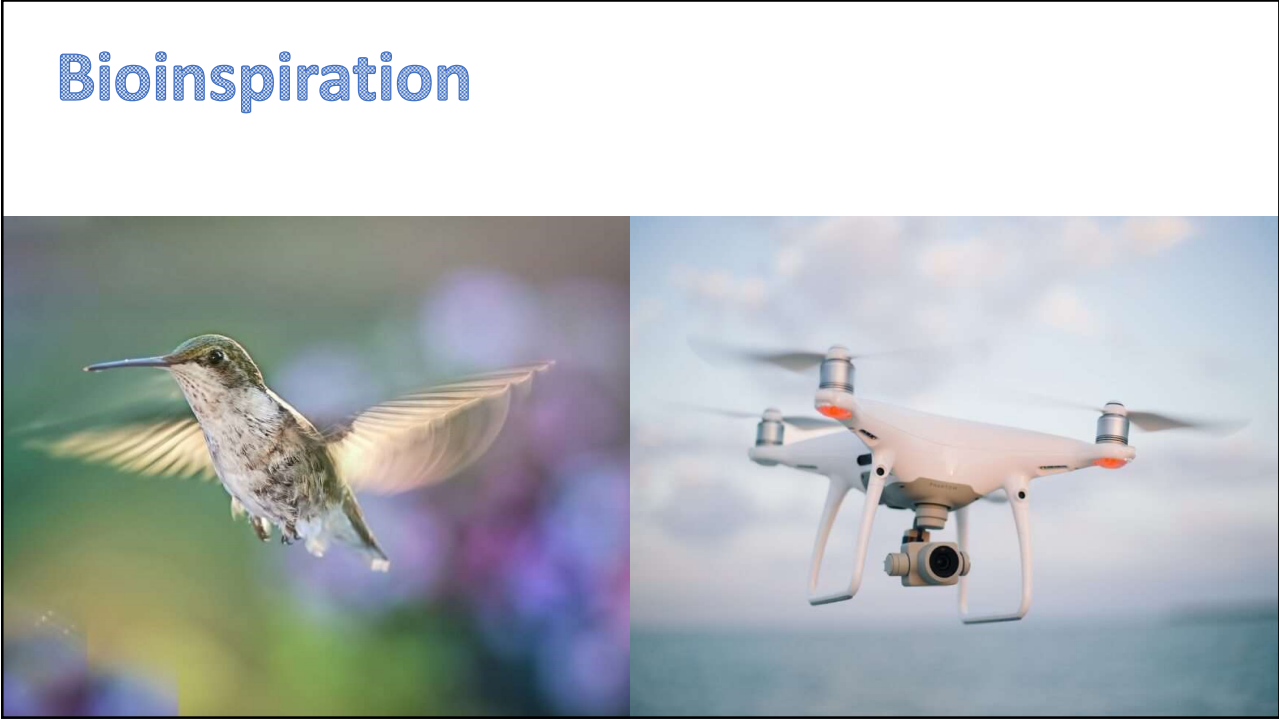
